### Deep Sea Fishing

### March 24<sup>th</sup>, 2026



Have you ever wanted to try offshore fishing before? If so, you should join the Club for a 10-hour fun-filled trip 30 miles out in the Gulf water aboard a 41-foot boat of **Hubbard's Marina boats in John's Pass, Madeira Beach!** The cost is about \$275 US per person for six people on the boat, and \$132 for 14 people. In such a case, the boat only goes 20 miles out in the Gulf (Coast Guard regulations), but we still catch a lot of fish. You can bring food and drink on board. They provide rods and bait. Upon return, they will clean your fish, and you get to keep them to feed your hungry family and friends! **Reserve ASAP with a \$100 deposit on February 11<sup>th</sup>, at the Club's luncheon, and the balance **BEFORE** February 28<sup>th</sup> - we need to pay the marina in advance.**
